- [ONGOING] ALBANIA: Strengthening the Offshore Hydrocarbon Sector:** DOI-ITAP will award a contract through its blanket purchase authority mechanism to provide ongoing technical assistance to Albania’s National Agency of Natural Resources with the objective of strengthening the Government of Albania’s ability to provide effective oversight of the country’s hydrocarbon sector, attract increased investment by qualified investors, boost revenues from oil and gas production for national benefit, and strengthen the safeguarding of the environment and communities in oil-producing regions. This work is funded by the U.S. Department of State.

- **[ONGOING] ARGENTINA: Sustainable Lithium Extraction:** DOI-ITAP is continuing to collaborate with USGS and the Departments of State and Commerce on the development and implementation of lithium cooperation between the U.S. and Argentina. DOI-ITAP and USGS experts are conducting bi-weekly virtual meetings and trainings with representatives from Argentina’s Ministry of Productive Development, the Argentine Geological Mining Service, and the three provinces of Catamarca, Jujuy, and Salta with the goal of creating a regional lithium resource inventory covering all three provinces. This work is funded by the U.S. Department of State.
- **[ONGOING] SOMALIA: Strengthening the Hydrocarbon Sector:** DOI-ITAP will award a contract through its blanket purchase authority mechanism to provide advisory services and technical trainings on geological and geophysical oversight, hydrocarbon data management and organization, agency organization and management strategy, and planning to Somalia’s Ministry of Petroleum and Mineral Resources and the Somali Petroleum Authority. This work is funded by the U.S. Department of State.
